JIMTOF 2012 (The 26th Japan International Machine Tool Fair) to Start Accepting the Online Registration from September 3 and to Announce Details of Lectures, Seminars and Special Exhibits

- A keynote speech about Foxconn inviting Dr. Takeo Nakagawa, President & CEO, Fine Tech Corporation, a recognized authority in the production and manufacturing field, and seminars regarding the Aerospace Industry will be provided. Special Exhibits titled "How the Shitamachi bobsleigh was born" will attract audiences. -

TOKYO, September 3, 2012 – JIMTOF 2012 (The 26th Japan International Machine Tool Fair jointly organized by JMTBA – Japan Machine Tool Builders' Association and Tokyo Big Sight Inc.), which is regarded as the largest exhibition in Asia, will be conducted at Tokyo Big Sight between November 1 (Thursday) and November 6 (Tuesday), 2012. The online registration is accepted from September 3 through the JIMTOF 2012 website (URL:www.jimtof.org/). And detailed contents of the lectures, seminars, and special exhibits, which will be conducted during JIMTOF 2012, have been decided.

JIMTOF 2012 will be conducted under the title of Harmony between the workmen's craft and state-of-the-art technology, "Mono-Zukuri Innovation" gathering 691 exhibitors, which is more than the previous JIMTOF 2010, from 19 countries and various areas throughout the world. In order to respond to high interest from the visitors towards production technologies, JIMTOF 2012 will develop various lectures, seminars, and special exhibits, etc.

• Keynote speech and special lectures

On the 1st day, November 1, a keynote speech titled "The biggest manufacturer in China, Foxconn" inviting Dr. Takeo Nakagawa, President & CEO, Fine Tech Corporation, who is a recognized authority in the production and manufacturing field, will be given. And three special lectures will be provided; Mr. Yoshio Hirakawa, Corporate Senior Vice President, Senior General Manager of Subaru Engineering Division of Fuji Heavy Industries Ltd. will make a speech titled "The

technologies for the Driving Assist System, EyeSight of Subaru on November 2, Mr. Akihisa Miwa, Director Senior Managing Executive Officer, Technology Division of Obayashi Corporation will lecture about the "TOKYO SKYTREE Construction" on November 5, and Mr. Yoshio Taoka, Senior Managing Director of Sumitomo Precision Products Co., Ltd. will give a special lecture titled "Manufacturing's future in the aircraft industry" on November 6.

• JIMTOF special seminars related to the Aerospace Industry

Additionally, on November 5, JIMTOF special seminars will be conducted under the theme of the Aerospace Industry, which is expected to be one of the pillar industries in the next generation, inviting four lecturers who are all recognized industry leaders. Mr. Hiroshi Suzuki, Program Execution General Manager of Mitsubishi Heavy Industries, Ltd., who has been working for rocket development, will make a speech about the present situation and the prospect of rocket developing / manufacturing, and Dr. Shinji Suzuki, Professor, University of Tokyo, who is an authority on aerospace engineering will give a lecture about the status quo and prospects of Japanese companies in the aircraft industry. Additionally, the developer of the "A380", the ultra large-sized aircraft of Airbus will make a presentation about customization management during the basic development phase of an aircraft, and Mr. Toshihiko Kasuya, General Manager, Engineering Dept. of Jamco Corporation, who was involved in developing interior tools for the "B-787", the latest and super-efficient airplane of Boeing, will speak about his experiences and future planning.

• Seminars targeting students and technical seminars

JIMTOF 2012 will also provide programs targeting students, which include a "Top seminar by machine tool manufacturers" on November 4, and a "Manufacturing industry & corporation research event for students" on November 6. During JIMTOF 2012, "The 15th IMEC (International Machine Tool Engineers' Conference)" will be conducted, and 34 exhibitors will make workshops to show their state-of-the-art technologies, and solutions
